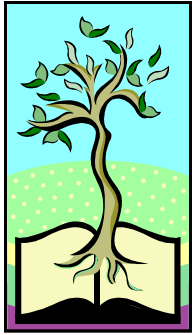

EGG HARBOR TOWNSHIP — Approximately 125 people attended the black-tie optional Winter Ball and Silent Auction held February 23 at the Hidden Creek Golf Club in Egg Harbor Township. Co-hosted by Shore Memorial Hospital and the *Community Partnership for Egg Harbor Township Schools, Inc.*, the event raised more than \$21,000 for Egg Harbor Township Schools including nearly \$4,000 in silent auction proceeds.
